The potential of a life is so great: made in the image of God, just a little lower than the angels, crowned with glory and honor. Man was made to have dominion over the "works of [God's] hands;" all things were "put under [man's] feet."¹ Yet, all around us we see a perversion of the majesty God has intended. Like Goliath of old, the enemy, giant and overpowering in his appearance, stands to mock and taunt God as he lords over those "majestic ones" who live in their fallen state. Promises of power, wealth and pleasures pour through the media, literature, art and often authority figures. Today, the innocent sparkle in a toddler's eyes so quickly turns to a smirk of greed, a seductive lure, a defiant rage, the glassy stare of drug abuse, or a dull defeated look of hopelessness or apathy as children enter their teenage years.

Like David, we must stand in the valley between that giant and our young majestic ones who have lost sight of or have never known the power of the living God who desires more than anything to dwell with them in a land of His choosing. Though we seem helpless in the face of the giants of drug abuse, violence, sexual perversions, and the very gates of hell, we will say, "Who is this uncircumcised Philistine that he should defy the armies of the living God?"² "You come to me with a sword, with spear, with a javelin. But, I come to you in the name of the Lord of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel whom you have defied. This day the Lord will deliver you into my hand..."³

God has promised that the simple stones of persistent fervent prayer will bring down even the worst enemy. Do we really believe that? Do our prayers reflect this ardent faith that God is alive and active in our lives and that He will prevail through His people for His glory? Do we see the majestic potential of the teens for whom we pray? Do we trust that the sparkle of abundant life and hope can return to our students' eyes as they fall in love with Christ Jesus and allow Him to restore them to Himself? Each day let us say, "Let no man's heart fail because of [this giant]; your servant will go and fight ..."

PRAYER GUIDE

In this prayer guide you will find a scripture that we will be using in our prayers for our children each day. The major theme for each day is given below.

SUNDAY – FEAR OF GOD

That they will fear the Lord and see His character

MONDAY – SALVATION

That they would know and love Christ as their Savior

TUESDAY – WISDOM

That God would give them a heart of wisdom and that they would put on righteousness and know right from wrong

WEDNESDAY – HATRED OF SIN

That they would be protected from the evil one. That they would hate sin and be caught when they do sin

THURSDAY – SUBMISSION

That they would respect and submit to the authority over them, and find joy in obedience

FRIDAY – FRIENDS

That they would desire the right friends and be protected from the wrong friends and crowd

SATURDAY – MATE & PURITY

That they and their future mate will be kept pure for marriage
