In the past nine years the mighty wind of the Holy Spirit has blown the seeds of God's word across our country through the prayers of faithful prayer warriors. A mom in the Midwest told me of her dilemma a few years ago when she was faced with the fact that her two children were just about the only "youth group" in the church they were attending. About that time, a couple in the area introduced the Wall of Prayer materials to the congregation. She shared that many believers in the area began praying for the teens in that community and today there are 50 in the youth group! She told of the spiritual growth she had seen in her daughter especially.

A Wall of Prayer coordinator in West Texas told me last week of a godly gentleman, involved in a prison ministry, who continues to ask for the names of 80 students to give to prisoners who have become believers and now hunger and thirst for the word of God and seek to serve Him in praying for teens. How fervent these prayers must be. (It is our policy in the Wall of Prayer to give only the first names of students and prayer partners, but God knows exactly for whom we pray!)

A Coordinator in Canada wrote of 30 teens there being the subject of prayers. I don't know how materials got to Canada but God's ways are higher than our ways, His thoughts than ours. Likewise, I was told last week that there are moms in East Texas who use the Wall of Prayer materials as they come together to pray for the teens in their school.

This week I have received requests from two other communities for Wall of Prayer materials. In His mercy, God is allowing us to be a part of a great revival among our young people which can only come about through prayer. During this tragic time of error being taught in so many churches and blatant Satanic attacks on our teens, we have a Savior who is mighty and strong who listens to our prayers and acts on His promises. God has blessed us with a simple but very effective website where Wall of Prayer materials can be easily accessed. I encourage you to explore this website and share it with those interested in building a Wall of Prayer around the teens in their community. There is nothing powerful or magic about this prayer guide. It is merely a vehicle for using God's word to direct and empower our fervent prayers for our precious teens.
