As we turn our Bibles to Ephesians we are reminded that our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places. One of Satan's most effective and powerful weapons is deception. In John 8:44, he is called a liar and a deceiver.

Our concern at this time of great searching is that our teens will be deceived by false teaching. Jesus is truth. He is the way, the truth and the life, and no one comes to the Father except by faith in Christ alone (John 14:6). Jesus came as God in the flesh. He lived, died and was raised by the power of God, putting an end to the hold of sin and death on believers. Jesus said, "Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives, do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful (John 14:27)." The promise of eternal life, peace and joy by any other way is a lie (1 John 7).

In 2 Corinthians we see that the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses. In order to destroy the fortresses of deception and error we must arm ourselves with the truth of God's word and pray. In the gospel of Luke, Christ urges us to continue to persevere in prayer. He tells us to ask, to seek and to knock. Only Luke reveals what Jesus most wanted us to ask of our Heavenly Father. As He continues to encourage us with the fact that our earthly fathers would never give us a snake if we asked for a fish or a scorpion is we asked for an egg, "...How much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him." It is only by the working of the Holy Spirit that we will see a miracle in the lives of our students. It is only by the Spirit of the Living God that spiritual life is created. Christians are not reproduced by any human efforts or born of a union of God plus something. It is completely a new and different life given only from the very hand of God.

We are not asking that kids strive to conform to an external set of rules. We are pleading for God's mercy; that by His grace He would look upon one child with compassion and pour out His Holy Spirit to convict the student of his sin and need for cleansing. We are praying that God would create in him a new heart and a vibrant passion for the Lord Jesus with the sole purpose of bring Him glory and honor.

In this prayer guide you will find a scripture that we will be using in our prayers for our children each day. The major theme for each day is given below.

### **Sunday – Fear of God**

That they will fear the Lord and see His character

### **Monday – Salvation**

That God would give them a heart of wisdom and that they would put on righteousness and know right from wrong

### **Wednesday – Hatred of Sin**

### **Friday – Friends**

That they would desire the right friends and be protected from the wrong friends and crowd

### **Saturday – Mate & Purity**
