In 1850, 50,000 orphans were abandoned on the streets of New York, their immigrant parents having died on the ship on the way to America. With no money or way to fend for themselves, they slept in alleys and huddled for warmth in boxes or metal drums. To survive, the boys mostly stole, caught rats to eat or rummaged through garbage cans. Girls sometimes worked as “panel thieves” for prostitutes, slipping their hands through camouflaged openings in the walls to lift a wallet from a preoccupied customer. Horrified by the plight of these youngsters, a 26-year-old minister named Charles Loring Brace organized a unique solution: the Orphan Train. The orphans were packed into trains heading west and offered as sons or daughters to families in towns along the way. By 1929, 100,000 children had found new homes. Two became governors, one a U.S. congressman and another a U.S. Supreme Court justice.

Imagine one day being a street urchin and three days later pulling into a Michigan town where you are selected by a kindly middle-aged couple who drive you to the largest house you have ever seen, and quietly explain that you are now part of their family. Everything they have is yours to enjoy! (*The Student Bible*, Zondervan, p. 1229.)

How our Lord wants to offer this kind of miraculous gift of adoption to our teens. Out of the pit of despair and loneliness, out of the spiritual poverty where teens search for love and belonging in all the wrong places, Christ longs to cleanse them with His blood and spread His garment of righteousness over them (Eph. 1) He will never leave them or forsake them. He will make them know the paths of life. In His presence is fullness of joy and at His right hand there are pleasures forever. (Ps.16:11)

He longs for them to grasp how wide and long and high and deep His love is for them and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that they may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. (Eph. 3:18-19)

Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within us, to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever! Amen. (Eph. 3:18-21)
