As we pray that our teens will come to know Christ as their personal Savior, that they may have true life—eternal life, the scriptures are full of ways to pray to this end. The name of Jesus, given to Joseph through the angel means, “the Lord is salvation” or, “the Lord shall save.” Christ, “the Anointed One,” was set apart—perfectly holy and fit for the office of Prophet, Priest, and King. Jesus Himself proclaims that He is the great “I Am.” Through out the gospels He reveals different aspects of His person that we may draw on to bring change in the lives of our students:

-I am the Light of the world. Jesus said this during the time of the feast of Tabernacles when the great candelabra was lit in the temple to remind God’s people of the pillar of fire that led the Israelites through the wilderness. Pray that not only will Jesus be the light that leads our students in the path of life He has planned for them, but that His light of conviction would shine in the dark, sinful places of their lives to show them their need for a Savior and bring about righteousness.

-I am the Good Shepherd; I am the door of the sheep. Even as the shepherd led his needy sheep to pleasant pastures and clean water, protecting them from predators by day and literally placing his body over the doorway of the protective enclosure by night, pray that our teens will follow the Great Shepherd into wholesome and wise places and that He will allow only those things that are needed to bring about His glory in the life of each one.

-I am the Way the Truth and the Life, no one comes to the Father but through Me. Pray that each student will come to know that Jesus is the only way to a vibrant life of truth, hope and joy.

-I am the Bread of Life. Pray that students would be nourished by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God as taken from His Word—the Bible.

-I am the Resurrection and the Life. Pray that, even as Jesus called Lazarus from the grave, He would soon call the name of your student to new life and that the student would come forth quickly!

-I am the True Vine. Pray that as your student is miraculously grafted to the True Vine through adoption, that he would live a fruitful life for the Kingdom of God bringing others to our Lord through the sweetness of His righteous fruit.

In this prayer guide you will find a scripture that we will be using in our prayers for our children each day. The major theme for each day is given below.

Sunday – Fear of God

That they will fear the Lord and see His character

Monday – Salvation

That they would know and love Christ as their Savior

Tuesday – Wisdom

That God would give them a heart of wisdom and that they would put on righteousness and know right from wrong

Wednesday – Hatred of Sin

That they would be protected from the evil one. That they would hate sin and be caught when they do sin

Thursday – Submission

That they would respect and submit to the authority over them, and find joy in obedience

Friday – Friends

That they would desire the right friends and be protected from the wrong friends and crowd

Saturday – Mate & Purity

That they and their future mate will be kept pure for marriage
