I was soon led to Ps. 121 "I will lift up mine eyes...my help comes from The Lord who created Heaven and earth" God promises three times never to get drowsy, never to slumber or sleep as he guards, preserves, protects, and nurtures those in His care-"Betsy". He will not let her foot slip, He will be her shade (shelter) at her right hand—her most powerful, yet vulnerable side. He will not let harm come to her during the day or at night. He will protect her from all evil and guard her as she steps out in the morning and comes back at night. For now and forever more He will abide with her.
