May 1 – July 31, 2009

The first time I truly heard God speaking to me—not audibly, but I would swear He was sitting right next to me—was in my college dorm room as I read Psalm 139. He let me know that the entire passage was true; that I could read the passage in first person. My life was never the same after I read, “O Lord, you have searched me and You know me. You know when I sit and when I rise. You perceive my thoughts from afar. You discern my going out and my lying down; You are familiar with all my ways. Before a word is on my tongue You know it completely, O Lord. You hem me in—behind and before; and You have laid your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain. Where can I go from Your Spirit? Where can I flee from Your presence? If I go up to the heavens, You are there; if I make my bed in the depths, You are there. If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, even there your hand will guide me, Your right hand will hold me fast. If I say, “Surely the darkness will hide me and light become night around me,” even the darkness will not be dark to You; the night will shine like the day, for darkness is as light to You. You created my inmost being; You knit me together in my mother’s womb. I praise You because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Your works are wonderful, I know that full well. My frame was not hidden from You when I was made in the secret place. When I was woven together in the depths of the earth, Your eyes saw my unformed body. All the days ordained for me were written in Your book before one of them came to be. How precious to me are Your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them! Were I to count them, they would outnumber the grains of sand. When I awake, I am still with You. If only you would slay the wicked, O God! Away from me, you bloodthirsty men! They speak of You with evil intent; Your adversaries misuse Your name...Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.”

Please pray that each and every student touched by our prayers will someday be able to “hear” the same Voice speaking these words of assurance: that HE knows them intimately, that they are precious and worthy in His sight and that He is watching over them-forever.
