August 1 – October 31, 2009

We have some very brave and courageous parents, teachers, counselors, coaches, and youth leaders being used of God to shepherd our teens in the paths of righteousness. Many have prayed daily for their students by name. Teachers have sought creative ways to teach truth, counselors have counseled from the premise that there is right and wrong and that it doesn't vary with each circumstance. We have seen coaches "bench" star athletes for bad attitudes or wrong behavior. As Paul writes to the Colossians, "we must devote ourselves to prayer on their behalf." Like Paul, their tongues are imprisoned, shackled in our schools from speaking the truth of God's sovereignty and creation and of man's dignity and worth-being made in the image of God and purchased by the shed blood of His Son. We must pray that "God will open a door to them so that they may speak the truth of Christ." "That God would make it clear in the way they ought to speak; and, that they would conduct themselves with wisdom, making the most of every opportunity.

James tells us that wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, full of mercy and good fruits, unwavering without hypocrisy. We'll pray that these shepherds would have a passion for the subject they are teaching and a love for the students they teach. Pray that the students would have ears to hear truth in every subject. That in math they would learn of God's order; in science they would learn of God's genius and creativity; in the arts, His majesty; and, in history, His sovereign hand over time.

In one community where we have been diligently praying for the past 3 year, God's hand has worked mightily through a Christian Choir director. This past spring, 40 choir students spent a week singing praises to God in cathedrals in Europe. In May, 22 seniors were given the opportunity to perform a musical selection of their choice and say a few words during a year-end program. Each of the 22 selected a spiritual song and each gave credit to Our Lord for their achievements.

While we have seen pockets of sweet truth and godly wisdom open up in our schools, there remains many thieves and robbers among our precious "lamb." The Greek word for thief conveys the idea of secretly stealing by fraud, while the Greek word for robber means to deprive another openly and by violence. We are appalled by those who secretly seduce and rape our teens; those who are disguised as their shepherds. Pray that satan's plan to rob our teens of their innocence and their emotional and physical health would be frustrated.

Though these may seem like impossible requests, with God nothing is impossible. Proverbs 21:1 assures us that "the king's heart is like channels of water in the hand of the Lord; He turns it wherever He wishes."

Sunday – Fear of God

Monday – Salvation

That they would know and love Christ as their Savior

Tuesday – Wisdom

That God would give them a heart of wisdom and that they would put on righteousness and know right from wrong

Wednesday – Hatred of Sin

That they would be protected from the evil one. That they would hate sin and be caught when they do sin

Thursday – Submission

That they would respect and submit to the authority over them, and find joy in obedience

Friday – Friends

That they would desire the right friends and be protected from the wrong friends and crowd

Saturday – Mate & Purity

That they and their future mate will be kept pure for marriage
