CHRISTMAS. The one and only Son of the Most High stepped down from His lofty, eternal position of omnipresence, omniscience and omnipotence to be confined to time, space and the trappings of flesh. The Creator, whose signature is written in the heavens and whose portrait is stretched over the earth<sup>1</sup>, labored as a carpenter for much of earthly His life.

Paul tells us that believers are Christ's workmanship.<sup>2</sup> After hours of prayer, and with His tools of love, forgiveness, and supreme sacrifice, a prostitute was restored to purity; a thieving tax-collector was given to generosity; a crazed, insane demoniac sat calm and in his right mind; and, a hot-tempered illiterate fisherman soon penned the divine words of Almighty God.

I think of Christ through the work of the Holy Spirit laboring as a carpenter today. Using a unique blueprint, sketched by His Father at the beginning of time, He transforms the sinful dead wood offered Him into beautiful, solid treasures useful to the Father and bearing His signature. In Mark 9:29 Jesus tells His disciples that this work takes much prayer.

While we have seen glimpses of changed lives through this ministry, we must never for a moment let up on this intense ministry of prayer. Satan's grip is tightening through the confusion of peer pressure, vulgar music, and loose boundaries. May the dead wood of strife, envy, rebellion, hatred, violence, substance abuse, and sexual promiscuity surrounding us, keep us on our knees as we plead with Jesus our Redeemer and Advocate to rebuild these young lives.

Pray fervently and persistently that our merciful Father will grant our youth a repentance leading to the knowledge of the truth and that they may come to their senses and escape from the snare of the devil, having been held captive by him to do his will.<sup>3</sup>
