“100s of Local High School Students Crowding into Area Churches to Declare Their Faith in Christ as Their Savior” Now there’s a headline we would all love to see. Is it true? No. Is it impossible? No.

Paul tells us God is invisible. That is true. However, invisible does not mean powerless. Invisible does not mean absent. What can an invisible God do? “By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God’s command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible.” (Hebrews 11:3)

Moses, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob each sought after a promise from God which they never saw, but each trusted God. For them as for us that which is invisible is more real than that which is visible.

God works in the course of things normally. It is only by faith that we see His hand. We believe our prayers are answered because of faith not empirical evidence. We may ask God to step in supernaturally, but He may respond quietly and subtly. Consider Revelation 8:1-5,

When he opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour. And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and seven trumpets were given to them. Another angel, who had a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense to offer, with the prayers of all God's people, on the golden altar before the throne. The smoke of the incense, together with the prayers of God's people, went up before God from the angel's hand. Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and hurled it on the earth; and there came peals of thunder, rumblings, flashes of lightning and an earthquake.

Our prayers are vital links in the final victory over evil, suffering, and death. Our invisible God is also our all powerful God. We need only look through the eyes of faith to see how He is answering our prayers for our students.

Prayer Guide

In this prayer guide you will find a scripture that we will be using in our prayers for our children each day. The major theme for each day is given below.

Sunday – Fear of God

That they will fear the Lord and see His character

Monday – Salvation

That they would know and love Christ as their Savior

Tuesday – Wisdom

That God would give them a heart of wisdom and that they would put on righteousness and know right from wrong

Wednesday – Hatred of Sin

That they would be protected from the evil one. That they would hate sin and be caught when they do sin

Thursday – Submission

That they would respect and submit to the authority over them, and find joy in obedience

Friday – Friends

That they would desire the right friends and be protected from the wrong friends and crowd

Saturday – Mate & Purity

That they and their future mate will be kept pure for marriage
