Her children and those who come into her home become a blessing to others through her wise teaching and godly example.

Few teens today are being raised toward this excellent design. Having no concept of inner strength, dignity or of modesty, many young ladies will become "dime store" rhinestones, rather than the exquisite gems God meant for them to be. While girls are groomed for the work force, a career or profession, how often we neglect training in the disciplines of maintaining a home and nurturing a family.

In a world where models and movie stars set the standard for fashion and where movies, computers and television are the pastime; where classic music, art and literature and domestic talents are dinosaurs, from where will the sweetness and goodness come in the next generations?

Tucked away in the Old Testament is the story of a young girl who was also being raised in an idolatrous, pagan nation. When a Hebrew family moved into her neighborhood to escape a famine in Judah, she was captivated by their stories of a true and living God. She soon married one of the sons. At the untimely death of her husband, his brother, and father, Ruth clung to her mother-in-law, Naomi, vowing to embrace her people, her land and her God. As the story unfolds, we see Ruth grow into the woman portrayed in Proverbs 31. Her loyalty to Naomi, her diligent work ethic and her chaste and respectful behavior won the heart of her kinsman redeemer, Boaz. This picture of the Holy Spirit of God drawing us to Jesus our Kinsman Redeemer, purchasing us from the poverty of sin and lavishly pouring His great love over us, gives us substance for our prayers. Pray that circumstances in the lives of these girls will bring them to the knowledge of the one, true life-changing God Who gave His Son as her kinsman redeemer and who has purchased her to first and foremost be His bride. Pray that the Holy Spirit will create in her the desire and the ability to become a Proverbs 31 woman. May the generations to come be forever changed by our prayers!
