Humanity was created in the image of God, made a little lower than the heavenly beings, and crowned with glory and honor.¹ God made us for fellowship with Himself and entrusted humanity with dominion over the works of His hands. Yet all around us we witness a tragic distortion of the glory God intended. Like Goliath of old, the enemy stands in arrogant defiance, mocking God and exerting influence over those who bear His image but live in a fallen condition. Promises of power, wealth and pleasures pour through the media, literature, art and often authority figures. Today, the innocent sparkle in a toddler's eyes so quickly turns to a smirk of greed, a seductive lure, a defiant rage, the glassy stare of drug abuse, or a dull defeated look of hopelessness or apathy as children enter their teenage years.

Like David, we must stand in the valley between that giant and our students who may have lost sight of or have never known the power of the living God who desires more than anything to dwell with them and lead them in the path of His choosing. Though we seem helpless in the face of the giants of broken homes, self-centeredness, pride, greed, power, drugs, violence, sexual perversions, and the very gates of hell, we will not shrink back, rather, we will say, "Who is this uncircumcised Philistine that he should defy the armies of the living God?"² "You come to me with a sword, with spear, with a javelin. But I come to you in the name of the Lord of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel whom you have defied."³ And we trust that the battle is the Lord's, and that He will deliver these students by His mighty hand.

God has promised that the simple stones of persistent fervent prayer will bring down even the worst enemy. Do we really believe that? Do our prayers reflect this ardent faith that God is alive and active in our lives and that He will prevail through His people for His glory? Do we see the immense potential of the teens for whom we pray? Do we trust that the sparkle of abundant life and hope can return to our students' eyes as they fall in love with Jesus Christ and allow Him to restore them to Himself? Each day let us say, "Let no man's heart fail because of [this giant]; your servant will go and fight ..."⁴
